On-screen interpretation of sonar reading (P1/2)

Follow these instructions to steer your vessel in such a way that your sonar device will give you detailed directions towards a found object.

Warning: Readings are extremely sensitive. If you take too long to follow instructions, the system may reset. For this reason, we recommend three users: one at sonar, one at the vessel's controls, and one on the outer deck.

If object is located in the North-West quadrant:

Controller should direct ship Left, unless -

- Waves of any level surround more than two sectors of the outer deck. If this is so, follow South-West instructions.
- Object is in an even-numbered ring. If this is so, Controller should direct ship Wright.

If object is located in the North-East quadrant:

Controller should direct ship Rightright, unless -

- Object is in the 1st or 2nd ring. If this is so, Controller should direct ship Wrightright.
- Only one sector of the outer deck is surrounded by rippling water. If this is so, follow South-East instructions.
